

WARNING!! THIS IS AN IMPORTANT DOCUMENT WHICH AFFECTS YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS. READ IT CAREFULLY AND DO NOT SIGN IT UNLESS YOU UNDERSTAND IT.

Hereby agree with the persons, organisations and bodies corporate whose names appear in schedule 1 (hereinafter collectively called the organisers) that I am by this agreement entitled to participate in the motorcycle activity/meeting held at the Bunbury Motorcycle Club Inc on the terms and conditions set out in this document.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF RISKS, DANGERS AND OBLIGATIONS.

I acknowledge that motorcycle sport is dangerous and that by engaging in the sport and participating I take am exposed to certain risks and dangers and am under certain obligations as follows.

- (a) That I may be injured physically or mentally and may be killed
- (b) That my machinery or equipment may be lost, damaged or destroyed
- (c) That other riders may ride dangerously or with lack of skill
- (d) That track or event conditions may be hazardous and may vary without warning or predictability.
- (e) That organisers, officials, landowners/track operators and any agents or representatives of those in charge of the club are frequently obligated to make decisions under pressure of time/ or events
- (f) That any policy of insurance of or in respect of my life or physical or metal health may be voided.
- (g) That there may be no or inadequate facilities for treatment or transport of me if I am injured.
- (h) That I have an obligation to myself and others to compete safely and within the rules of competition and club.

INDEMNITY GIVEN TO ORGANISERS.

In the consideration of the acceptance of me as a member to the Bunbury Motorcycle Club (BMCC), I agree to indemnify the organisers and members in the following manner.

- (a) That I participate at my sole risk and responsibility.
- (b) That I accept the venue as it stands with all or any defects hidden or exposed.
- (c) That I indemnify and hold harmless the organisers, their respective servants, agents or officials against my actions or claims which may be made by me or on behalf for or in respect of or arising out of my death or any injury loss or damage caused to me or my machinery or equipment whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any other matter whatsoever.

(2) That I/WE (print names).....
being of reasonable mechanical knowledge or if not have someone of reasonable mechanical knowledge of such rules perform the following checks to all equipment to be used while using these premises or any other promoted by the BMCC inc.

- Handle bars to be no bigger than stated in the MA GCR's and are to be plugged at each end
- All tyre and wheels to be in apparent good condition and should not have loose or broken spokes, wheel bearings or mounting implements.
- All bearings including steering head, swing arm and suspension components but not limited to will be in good condition
- All levers will comply to original manufactures standards.
- Chains and sprockets will be in good order to limit the chance of a failure in this area.
- All retaining devices will be tensioned to manufactures specifications

EQUIPMENT

No member may practice, start or compete in any event organised or affiliated with the BMCC unless wearing

- Approved and correctly fitting helmet which complies with AS1698
- Trousers of leather or synthetic material of similar fibre and must be of a non combustibile material
- Jersey of a close knit fabric or natural or synthetic fibre and must be a snug fit and provide protection against abrasion to the body and arms
- Footwear which must be of recognised motocross type
- Spectacles and goggles may be worn provided they are made of a non-shattering material (metal or Perspex's face shields are not to be used) eye shades and peaks are to be of a flexible material.

IN ADDITION

Juniors must wear commercially manufactured body armour. They may use synthetic or rubber boots where There boot size is smaller than size one.

ALL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT MUST BE OF A CLOSE FITTING NATURE AND MAY NOT BE ALLOWED TO FLAP OR TO BE WORN LOOSE. ALL SAFETY RULES AS STATED IN (MA GCR'S) ARE TO BE ADHERED TOO.

2.1 That my machine and equipment will be in such condition before each time that I use such equipment while riding at any event or venue that involves the BMCC.

2.2 I will not use these premises or any other venue that the BMCC is involved in until I have a national competition licence or have completed the required riding test to be performed in front of licence adjudicator and have passed both the practical and written test.

2.3 Practice times all days (ie from the hour to ¼ past juniors ¼ past ½ past seniors and so on) indicator board indicating who is current on track to be displayed on pit exit and on tree at table top in start straight (when necessary). First lap to be a slow lap to check for changes in track conditions and if any such lap indicates that the track shall not be ridden on, then under the Duty of Care, I will not ride on the track and inform others at the track of my decision not to ride and the reason for my decision.

2.4 No one to ride at track unaccompanied as per level 1 and over official's requirement's.

2.5 1 directional riding (no cutting track unless bike is being wheeled)

2.6 No permitting non members into track for practice

2.7 Photocopy proof of Ambulance cover to be supplied prior to membership being accepted

2.8 Practice is to be treated as such and all due care should be taken not to endanger ones self or others that may be practicing at same time


2.9 No riding outside of designated track area.

2.10 When driving vehicle within the confines of the club's premises, I will not exceed 20km/h

2.11 Breaches of rules will be deemed as a criminal offence and met with termination of membership and key removal, police to be notified if necessary.
